## PHOTOGRAPHS

All season pass types and Frequent Cards require a digital photo of the pass holder. For express processing at collection or for the post out option you will need to include a full colour, passport-sized photograph (true likeness) of yourself with your application – please ensure your name is on the back. If you are unable to send in a photo, we can take one at the time of pass collection. If you had a pass with us in 2007 or 2008 you have the option to re-use the photograph already on file, provided it remains a true likeness.

## 2009 TERMS & CONDITIONS

The following Terms & Conditions apply to your nzskipass, Regional Pass, The Remarkables Pass, Mt Hutt Midweek Pass or Frequent Card as indicated within the text.

The operating season of the NZSki Limited (NZSki) areas is nominally Coronet Peak 6 June - 4 October 2009, The Remarkables 20 June - 11 October 2009 and Mt Hutt 13 June - 18 October 2009. Season length is subject to snow, weather and market conditions and the season may be longer or shorter than indicated. NZSki makes no warrant as to the length of season, number of lifts operating at any time or to the operation or otherwise of an area on any particular day.

Purchase of a pass implies acceptance of the following Terms & Conditions:

### PART A – APPLIES TO ALL PASS HOLDERS, 2009

- 1 The pass is not transferable. It may only be used by the person whose name and photograph it bears and the original application may not be transferred to another person.
- 2 Fraudulent use of your pass will result in confiscation and prosecution for all parties involved.
- 3 Your pass cannot be used for commercial purposes.
- 4 A lost or stolen pass must be reported immediately. Replacement of a lost or stolen card will incur a \$35 administration fee.
- 5 Photo identification is required on collection of your pass/card.
- 6 All card holders must abide by the ski area user responsibility code. Misconduct will result in the withdrawal or suspension of the pass with no refund. Misconduct includes, but is not limited to, reckless or dangerous skiing or riding, excessive speed within a slow or learning zone, disregard for closed areas, unsocial behaviour, skiing or riding under the influence of alcohol or drugs, supply of incorrect information or breach of the conditions as per the Snow Responsibility Code available at [www.nzski.com](http://www.nzski.com).
- 7 Season passes are non-refundable unless the Injury/Medical cover option has been purchased. If Injury/Medical cover has been purchased, passes are fully refundable until opening day of the applicable ski area and from opening day passes will be refunded on a pro-rata basis. In all cases refunds will only be made on medical grounds injury or medical condition which precludes or significantly limits ability to use the pass. All applications for pass cancellation and refund must be supported with a doctor's certificate. Pro-rated refunds will be calculated from the relevant ski area opening day (any ski area in the case of the nzskipass) or date of collection, whichever is the later, and is available for up to 6 weeks. On expiration of the 6 week period, no refunds are available. Refunds extend to the value of the pass type purchased only and do not cover any ancillary or other associated costs.

- 8 You must carry your pass with you at all times when skiing or riding.
- 9 Use of any season pass is subject to the Terms & Conditions of the specific ski area at which you are using the pass.

### PART B – SPECIFIC TO SEASON PASS TYPES, 2009

- 1 The nzskipass provides the holder with unlimited skiing and riding at Coronet Peak, The Remarkables and Mt Hutt for the 2009 season during standard operating hours of

9am - 4pm, plus Night Skiing at Coronet Peak on Friday and Saturday nights from 4pm - 9pm when available.

- 2 The Mt Hutt and Queenstown Regional Passes provide holders with unlimited skiing and riding at the relevant regional area only for the 2009 season during standard operating hours of 9am - 4pm. In addition holders are entitled to a 50% discount on the standard day pass rates at the other NZSki region. The Queenstown Pass includes unlimited Night Skiing at Coronet Peak during the 2009 season on Friday and Saturday nights when available.
- 3 The Remarkables Pass provides holders with unlimited skiing and riding at The Remarkables only for the 2009 season during standard operating hours of 9am - 4pm. The Remarkables Pass is limited to Queenstown Lakes District residents only. Proof of Queenstown Lakes District residence will be required at pass collection, in the form of a bank statement or utility bill in the pass holder's name, dated within the last month and with the pass holder's physical address listed. The Remarkables pass holders receive Frequent Card discounts at Coronet Peak and Mt Hutt throughout the season.
- 4 The Mt Hutt Midweek Pass provides holders with unlimited skiing and riding, Monday-Friday at Mt Hutt only for the 2009 season during standard operating hours of 9am - 4pm. Mt Hutt Midweek Pass holders receive Frequent Card discounts at Mt Hutt on the weekends and any day of the week at Coronet Peak and The Remarkables.
- 5 The First Tracks Extension provides access to the Coronet Express lift from 8am - 9am from late June / early July through to late in the 2009 season. The operation of First Tracks is subject to the availability and operation of the lifts and to snow & weather conditions. Access to trails will be subject to operational requirements, weather and snow conditions and any scheduled race/events. Coronet Peak does not guarantee the operation of First Tracks on any particular day.
- 6 The Transport Extension provides coach transport to and from Coronet Peak and The Remarkables ski areas, departing from the Queenstown Snow Centre for the duration of the 2009 season during standard operating hours. Seats are available on a first come, first served basis.
- 7 Holders of all NZSki season pass types (excluding Frequent Card) are entitled to purchase a 2009 Oahu season pass for \$89 before 1 May 2009 (inclusive) or \$139 from 2 May 2009. You will be required to present your NZSki season pass at the time of Oahu pass collection. - 9 A day lift pass may be issued if a season pass holder has forgotten their pass, for an administration fee of \$10.00. The season pass will be deactivated for the duration of that day.
- 10 Cardholder conditions as in Part A above also apply.

### PART C – TERMS & CONDITIONS SPECIFIC TO FREQUENT CARDS, 2009

- 1 The Frequent Card gives you a discount on all variations of day passes at Coronet Peak, The Remarkables and Mt Hutt, including Night Skiing at Coronet Peak.
- 2 Your Frequent Card must be presented at the point of sale to obtain the discount, and may only be presented once daily per pass holder.
- 3 Frequent Cards are not refundable.
- 4 Cardholder conditions as in Part A above also apply.

### FREQUENT CARD

This card is ideal for those who love to ski and ride but do not want to commit to a full season pass. It acts as a discount card for lift passes – refer Discounts section for day pass savings.

### CHILD AND SUPER SENIOR APPLICATIONS

For convenience, we can produce a season pass for children aged 6 years and under at Coronet Peak and Mt Hutt and children aged 10 years and under at The Remarkables, or super seniors aged 75+. Both of these groups would normally receive free day lift passes however this pass enables the holder to proceed direct to the lifts and avoid a visit to Guest Services on a daily basis. There is a \$35 application and card issue fee.

### AGE DEFINITIONS (as at 6 June 2009)

<b>Adult</b>	18 to 64 years (inclusive)
<b>Student</b>	18+ years enrolled full time with a New Zealand or Australian tertiary institution or secondary school. To be considered full time you must attend such institution a minimum of 32 weeks in a calendar year. Student ID <u>and</u> proof of full time status in the form of a letter from the institution to be presented at the time of pass collection. ID card must be in English and include a valid expiry date. ISIC cards not accepted.
<b>Youth</b>	7 – 17 years
<b>Senior</b>	65 – 74 years (proof of age may be required)
<b>Super Senior</b>	75+ years
