- ✚ This programme is for “**non snowsports-qualified person**” and only for **New Zealanders & Australians**.
- ✚ The Selection clinic for the Apprentice Rookie is 1 day of skill improvement and is an opportunity to start an apprenticeship teaching Skiing or Snowboarding
- ✚ Following the 1 day on-snow training, successful participants will be advised of selection
- ✚ If selected, Apprentice-Rookies will become employees of NZSki Ltd for the Winter season
- ✚ Work is not guaranteed, however we will supply training and a staff ID card/Seasons pass (includes access to lift) to selected participants
- ✚ Selected Apprentice-Rookies need to have enough money to support themselves through the season. Work will be available but could be variable due to the nature of our business
- ✚ When we are not able to provide work, we are committed to training you to a Level One and Level Two NZSIA/SBINZ instructor level
- ✚ Training will be provided by highly qualified and experienced Instructors
- ✚ The basis of training will be on-snow clinics, shadowing workshops and video work
- ✚ Each Apprentice-Rookie are expected to do the NZSIA Level One Certificate in Snowsports Instruction and to do the Level Two exams at their own expense.

- ✚ Apprentice-Rookies must be at least 16 years of age to sit the Level One exam and 17 years of age for Level Two exam.
