- ✎ This programme is for **New Zealanders and Australians who are non-snowsports qualified.**
- ✎ It is the selection clinic for apprentice rookies. The programme involves a full day of coaching and skill improvement and is your opportunity to start an apprenticeship teaching skiing or snowboarding. Successful participants will be advised if they have been selected following the one day training session.
- ✎ If selected, apprentice rookies will become NZSki employees for the winter season.
- ✎ Work is not guaranteed, however we will supply training and a staff ID card/season pass (includes access to lift) to the selected participants.
- ✎ Selected apprentice rookies need to have sufficient funds to support themselves through the season. Work will be available but could be variable due to the nature of our business.
- ✎ When we are not able to provide work, we are committed to training you to a Level One and Level Two NZSIA / SBINZ instructor level.
- ✎ Training will be provided by highly qualified and experienced instructors.
- ✎ The basis of training will be on-snow clinics, shadowing workshops and video work.
- ✎ Each apprentice rookie is expected to do the NZSIA / SBINZ Level One Certificate in Snowsports Instruction and Level Two exams at their own expense.
- ✎ Early registration is not just recommended but a **necessity** at www.nzsia.net or www.sbinz.net
- ✎ Apprentice rookies must be at least 16 years of age to sit the Level One exam and 17 years of age for Level Two exam.

Qualified instructors will need to apply for jobs through the Snowsports School or sign up and participate in our Casual Hiring Clinic on 15th June 2012.
