PEAK GONDOLA PASS

Sit back and enjoy a gondola ride to 1649m, where you will be high above the valley below. Enjoy world famous views over the Wakatipu Basin and back to the divide of the Southern Alps. Our viewing platform is suitable for all and perfect for families or those looking for an iconic wedding photo or you can take a short hike to the summit for the ultimate 360° view.

CAFÉ 1200

Prefer your coffee or lunch with a view? Dine at Café 1200, located in our base building, where you can choose from the all-day menu or freshly prepared cabinet food while soaking up the sun on our spacious deck. A selection of local Central Otago wine and craft beer is available along with hot and cold drinks.

CORONET PEAK SHOP

The retail shop at Coronet Peak is stocked for all those last-minute necessities as well as some great clothing options suited to our alpine environment. There's also a mountain bike workshop which will do its best to keep your wheels rolling if the unexpected happens.

FRISBEE GOLF

Our 9x hole disc golf course provides some competitive entertainment. Guests can catch the gondola up to the top then make their way down navigating 9x disc golf holes all the way to the base. Discs/frisbees can be rented on mountain.

MOUNTAIN BIKING

Grab your mountain bike and make the most of the natural terrain at Coronet Peak. Starting at the top of the Coronet Express chairlift, our trails are fun, flowy and technical with breathtaking alpine views. You can expect an epic time, and because trails are accessed by chairlift it means you get faster laps and more vertical. Bring your own bike or rent one from Torpedo 7 on mountain. A range of passes are available with a day, sunset or season pass on offer.

CORONET PEAK LOCATED IN QUEENSTOWN NEW ZEALAND,

was the country's first commercial ski field, providing good times since 1947. The mountain is Queenstown's urban playground only 20 minutes from downtown and is now open to guests in both summer and winter.

In summer guests are treated to scenic gondola rides up to 1649m. From here they can soak in the views from our accessible viewing platform or take a short hike up to the summit for impressive 360 views over the Wakatipu Basin and back towards the Main Divide.

There's also the option to stretch the legs by choosing to walk one way and take the gondola the other - perfect for enjoying the fresh mountain air and native flora.

Summer also means mountain bikers can experience the fun, flowing technical trails from the top of Coronet Express chairlift. with bike rentals, a workshop and retail store.

In winter, Coronet Peak has 280ha of skiable terrain. Guests are treated to freshly groomed trails during First Tracks from 8am daily, right through to Night Skiing two nights a week in July and August until 9pm.
