

PEAK GONDOLA PASS

Sit back and enjoy a gondola ride 1649m above the valley floor. Soak-in the epic scenery looking over Queenstown, Lake Wakatipu and back towards the towering Southern Alps. Walk out onto our viewing platform, suitable for all ages – a perfect spot to capture a quintessential Queenstown snap, or take a short hike to the summit for the ultimate 360° view.

CAFÉ 1200

Grab a bite to eat at Café 1200 at the base of the gondola. Choose from an all-day menu or freshly prepared cabinet food before relaxing on our sun-deck. A hand-picked selection of local Central Otago wine and craft beer is available alongside non-alcoholic choices.

CORONET PEAK SHOP

Our retail shop has a finely tuned selection of biking gear, clothing and accessories. If anything unexpected happens or you forget the necessities – hit up the shop. Coronet Peak's mountain bike workshop team will do their best to keep your wheels rolling too.

FRISBEE GOLF

Our nine hole disc golf course provides some competitive entertainment. Guests can catch the gondola up to the top then make their way down navigating nine disc golf holes all the way to the base. Discs/frisbees can be rented on mountain.

MOUNTAIN BIKE SHUTTLE

Shuttle service from the bottom of Hot Rod - Coronet Peak Station Rd, base of the mountain - Malaghans Rd. and Rude Rock crossing - Skippers Saddle.

MOUNTAIN BIKING

Grab your mountain bike and make the most of the terrain at Coronet Peak. Starting at the top of the Coronet Express chairlift, our trails are fun, flowing and technical with breathtaking alpine views. Chairlift access means faster laps and more vertical. Bring your own bike or rent one from Torpedo7 on mountain.
