This special event is for our up and coming skiers and riders to get a taste of what it's like to compete in freeride. Hosting by Blake Marshall and Hannah Wilson.




# **BURTON STASH GATHERING**

It's time to party on the slopes with Snow Machine – the best vibe around, great music and a whole lot of fun.




# **ABOUT US**

We've already reduced our emissions by over 50%, and we continue to chip away at that number with the aim of reducing a further 5% each year.

## **SNOWMAKING**

Extensive automated system comprising 158 guns covering beginners' area, Alta Green, Casterway, Gotham City, Curvey, Cross Fall, Serpentine, Turquoise, Waterfall, and terrain parks.

## LIFTS

Three high-speed six-seater chairs, one quad chair, four surface conveyor lifts including three with covered galleries.

**AVERAGE SNOWFALL** 3.67m per annum (excl. snowmaking).

**ACCESS** 24km, 45min from Queenstown (9km sealed and 4km unsealed access road).

**TERRAIN** 30% beginner, 40% intermediate, 30% advanced.

**NON SKIERS** Chairlift to sightseeing access point and a toboggan area.

**SNOWSPORTS** Private and group coaching available as well as high performance camps and adaptive programmes.

KIDS PROGRAMMES Ages 4-5 years & 5-16 years.

**FOOD & BEVERAGE** Restaurant and bar services, cafe, Corona Ice Bar, and Barista Bar.

**RENTALS** Recreational and performance rental gear available as well as an on-mountain workshop for equipment tuning.

# **ROAD TO CARBON NEUTRAL**

The Remarkables belongs to family owned and operated business – NZSki. Our sister mountains are across the valley at Coronet Peak and further north at Methven's Mt Hutt.

At NZSki our primary greenhouse gas emission sources are diesel fuel - used for grooming, transport and building heating - and electricity. Together our three mountains produce approximately 3000 Tonnes of greenhouse gas emissions (Scope 1 and 2 only) annually.

#### HOW WE'RE MAKING A DIFFERENCE

#### **WASTE REDUCTION:**

In 2024, we introduced Sorting Stations to our food/drink outlets, reducing waste to landfill by 42% through better recycling and reusable tableware.

#### TRANSPORT EFFICIENCY:

Our carpool priority initiative at Mt Hutt cut guest-related emissions by 30%, saving around 11 tonnes of CO2 per day at our sister mountain.

## **SUPPORT FOR CONSERVATION:**

In 2024, we raised \$21,700 for the Kea Conservation Trust and \$29,800 for the Westpac Rescue Helicopter Trust.

#### **RENEWABLE ELECTRICITY:**

We've partnered with Meridian Energy to use their Certified Renewable Energy product. This allows us to report our mountain market-based Scope 2 emissions as zero.\*

## **CARBON CREDITS:**

We've purchased carbon credits from Climate Action Company (formerly Carbonz). Since 2022 we have purchased 1336 tonnes of carbon credits to offset emissions.
